

## Cleaning and Maintenance Instructions

The StoneKAST bath you have purchased for your home is an investment that will provide years of luxurious bathing and a unique centrepiece for your bathroom. StoneKAST is a natural product so simple care and maintenance will preserve its beauty for years to come.

Here are some recommendations for routine care and cleaning.

We would recommend either a mild detergent or, for tougher stains, a cream cleaner such as Cif to clean the matt surface of StoneKAST products. Use a clean and soft cloth for best results. Too much detergent or soap may leave a film and cause streaks. Do not use products that contain lemon, vinegar or other acids. Rinse the surface thoroughly after washing with the soap solution and dry with a soft cloth. Change the rinse water frequently.

## When not in use

Dust your StoneKAST Bath frequently using a clean non-treated dry duster.

## Do's and Don'ts

Do clean surfaces with mild detergent or cream cleaner

Do thoroughly rinse and dry the surface after washing

Don't use vinegar, lemon juice or other cleaners containing acids

Don't use cleaners that contain acid such as conventional bathroom cleaners, grout cleaners or tub & tile cleaners

Don't mix bleach and ammonia; this combination creates a toxic and lethal gas
